**Terms & Conditions for OCBC-Great Eastern Pickleball Open 2026 – OCBC Cardmembers
and OCBC App Promotions (“Promotions”)**

Eligibility

1. OCBC credit/debit card members will be entitled to a 10% discount off the prevailing registration fee when they sign up for OCBC-Great Eastern Pickleball Open 2026 (the “Event”) with their OCBC cards via the Official Event Website.
2. To enjoy 10% discount, enter the first 6 digits of your OCBC debit/credit card at the check-out page.
3. First 100 players who register from 24 July 2026 via the Official Event Website using OCBC App (“Players”) will receive S\$2 in cashback if they register for the applicable categories under clause 4 below (“Cashback”). The Cashback will be credited via PayNow to the mobile number provided in the Event’s registration form.
4. This Promotion is non-transferable and cannot be combined with other promotions unless expressly stated otherwise.

General

5. The Promotions are only applicable for registration under the following categories:
 - a) Open
 - b) Novice
 - c) Bank of Singapore Corporate Challenge (excluding group payment)
6. The eligibility of any Player to participate in the Promotions and/or enjoy any Cashback shall be determined at the absolute discretion of Oversea-Chinese Banking Corporation Limited (“Event Owner”).
7. The Event Owner reserves the right at its absolute discretion to terminate the Promotions or vary, delete or add to any of these terms and conditions at any time without notice including without limitation, the eligibility of any player and the dates of the Promotion.
